Awareness. Help the Helpless provides this Donor Privacy Policy to make you aware of our privacy policy, and to inform you of the way your information is used. We also provide you with the opportunity to remove your name from our mailing list, if you desire to do so.

How Information is Used. Help the Helpless uses your information to understand your needs and provide you with better service. No Sharing of Personal Information. Help the Helpless will not sell, rent, trade, or lease your personal information to other organizations. In addition, we will not send you information on behalf of other organizations. We assure you that the identity of all our donors will be kept confidential. Use of donor information will be limited to the internal purposes of Help the Helpless only to further the ministry activities and purposes of Help the Helpless.
